Meeting held 13 September 2023 at the Walt Library at 6:30 PM CDT. Officer reports:

- **Exchequer (Lady Lhiannan):** the barony coffers total \$12393.46. There are eight outstanding checks, please cash them before she submits her third quarter Exchequer Report [October 15th]. The storage unit rent is due at the end of the year. Three members of the financial committee need to email proof of their SCA membership to exchequer@magmor.calontir.org.
- 2 Gold Key (Lady Morgana): The rolling rack and bins for loaner gear are working out well.
- ② Arts and Sciences (Lady Morgana): Next A&S meeting is the 4th of October, topic to be announced. Please send ideas to Lady Morgana for future A&S nights.
- ② Chronicler (Lord Carlos): Not in attendance. [Update from Lady Cera: Please send your contributions to the Runestaff by 5:00 PM on Sunday. Expect a post on Facebook regarding updating your information in the directory.]
- ② **Herald (Lord Fasti):** Not in attendance. [Update from Tofa: There has been no new herald activity since the last meeting.]
- ② **Webminister (Laurentia):** working on transferring all officer emails. Three officers have never signed into their official emails. Minister of Youth, Archery Marshall, and Herald, please contact her with your personal emails so your accounts can be reset.
- That Chatelaine (Lord Aurik): Upcoming demonstrations are in the planning process. The first is

Thursday, October 5th, at the UNL daycare. The expected time slot is 5:30 to 6:15 PM. Light activities and a combat demonstration are possibilities. Please suggest activities suitable for children under the age of 10 to Lord Aurik. The second demonstration is scheduled December 12th at Park Middle School. The 12th is a Tuesday and is an early-release day so the demonstration will begin at approximately 2:00 PM. This may be an extra credit activity for the students (last year's students had a checklist of activities). The duration is currently unspecified, but will probably last until the normal end of the school day.

- ② Minister of Youth (Lady Adelheid): Cattle Raids had the last officially scheduled youth activities, there has been nothing to report since.
- ☑ Media Cryer (Lord Jean): Not in attendance. [Update from Tofa: Most social media activity for the quarter surrounded Cattle Raids 2023; flyers for youth activities, highland games, A&S classes, scheduling and site map were posted on the socials. Addressed questions in the Calontir main page and Public Mag Mor accounts. During the event, posted signs for the classes and competitions and helped the youth activity coordinators. Next event coming up to keep in mind Winter Court. ~Jean Jolivet]
- ② Archery (Lord Yoichi): Due to the earlier arrival of sunset and some personal events, the last outdoor archery practice of the year will be this week (Sept 14th). Attendance at practices has been low, with 2-5 people (Yoichi included). If throwing practice attendance doesn't pick up (only one person showed at the last practice), Lord Yoichi will hold only archery practice in the future. His Cattle Raids report: Thank you to the people who helped set up the archery range, initially and when it needed to be moved. Johnson County had scraped the grass off the proposed archery range, which left a dusty mess that became a muddy mess after the rain. The whole range had to be moved and reset. The shoot got off to a late start but everyone had a good time.

- ② Marshall's report (HE Volkmar): Fighter practices have been poorly attended, though everyone is still having fun with it. Outdoor practices at the park will end in September. Indoor practices begin in October. We will check with the Northern Lighthouse church to secure the location. Guild reports

Moot notes

Meeting held 18 October 2023 at the Walt Library at 6:30 PM CDT. 15 people in person, 3 online.

Officer reports:

Exchequer (Lady Lhiannan): The barony coffers total \$13923.06. We just received \$1629.60 Total income. \$1569.60 from 2022 Cattle Raids pre-registration, received at Coronation. Some logistical issues led to the delay in receiving these funds. Additional income: \$30 income for barony trim, \$30 from fighter donations. The barony's storage locker rent is paid through the end of Dec. We will make two payments to the fighter practice site in November.

- 2 Gold Key (Lady Morgana): No change in activity since last month.
- Arts and Sciences (Lady Morgana): We are starting thoughts of the Yule celebration. The A&S meeting in November needs a facilitator. Her Ladyship Natalya offered to present a talk on journeymen. [Note from Tofa: There was a proposal to make a permanent change in the meeting schedule, moving A&S to the second Wednesday of the month. More discussion on this in New Business.]
- ② Chronicler (Lord Carlos): Not in attendance. [Note from Tofa: Lord Carlos requests updated contact information from barony members. Please email the Chronicler at chronicler@magmor.calontir.org with your contact information. The Directory will be distributed in November.]
- Perald (vacant): Noble Fasti has stepped down from this position. Lord Jean has offered his services in the role, as he is the deputy, Herald.
- ② **Webminister (Laurencia):** reports that the officer emails have occasional glitches. She is looking into the problem, but has nothing to report at this time.
- ☑ Chatelaine (Lord Aurik): The demonstration was delivered to a lower-than-usual age range but still well-received. There were paper crafts, photo opportunities, and a combat demo. The next demonstration is slated for 12 December on early release day for Park Middle School. The 12 th is a Wednesday. The kids are released around 2:30 PM. More information forthcoming.
- Minister of Youth (Lady Adelheid): Is suffering from COVID, so no report.
- Media Cryer (Lord Jean): Past quarter, has worked with youth combat advertisements. Winter court is coming up; the December 12 demonstration will also be advertised. He has also been working with Youth Combat
- ② Archery (Lord Yoichi): Archery practice for the year has ended. The schedule for the baronial championship archery shoot has not been decided, due to other obligations. Lord Yoichi stood in for our baronial champion at Autumn arrows and represented the Barony well by placing second.
- ② Largess Coordinator (Lady Emma): Have largesse on a shelf, safe from her cat.
- Marshall's report (HE Volkmar): Fighter practices have moved indoors to the Northern Lighthouse church. Lady Lhiannon has paid ahead to secure the site. We may possibly entertain skilled visiting fighters at the 24 October practice.

Guild reports:

② Scribes (HE Gyda): Unfortunately, the plan to obtain scrolls from the Royal Scribe fell through. During her vacation in New York, she took 1100 photos of scroll-like objects and New York. She will be pleased to share them with anyone who asks. The Morgan also has Gutenburg Bibles and has planned an event lasting 20 October 2023 to 21 January 2024 [Tofa: see also https://www.themorgan.org/collection/Gutenberg-Bible and https://www.themorgan.org/exhibitions/morgan-bibles.] Her Excellency has also acquired 20 sheets of paper suitable for scrolls (8.5″ x 11″) and has the opportunity to order more.
