Directions to site: From the South:

Take your best route to Nebraska City and NE Hwy 2. Travel West on Hwy 2 toward Lincoln, 43 miles. Take the exit toward South 14th St. In about 650 ft, at the traffic circle, take the 3rd exit onto Saltillo Rd. In 0.2 miles, at the traffic circle, take the 1st exit onto Shrine Way. Take the 1st right into the Sesostris Shrine parking lot.

From the East:

Take your best route to Omaha, Interstate 80, heading west. Stay on I-80 W, 52 miles. Take exit 397 for US-77 toward Beatrice. In ½ mile, keep left to continue on US-77/Homestead Expy. After 8.8 miles take the

Saltillo Rd exit; at the traffic circle, take the 2nd exit onto Shrine Way. Take the 1st right into the Sesostris Shrine parking lot.


Armored Fighter/Cut & Thrust Practice:

A Visit to Trimaris

I recently took another trip south—and this time I visited not only my grandchildren, but also Bentonshire in the Kingdom of Trimaris. I attended a small event called the "Battles of

The woman who won both Stile competitions had traveled even farther than I

did – she was from the Kingdom of Lochac (Australia). She was awarded a coin by the Prince of Trimaris, Sir Logan the Gardener, in a field court, and then during the final court of the day, received her Champion titles.

So much of the day was familiar, as SCA culture has its rhythms, but it was a little strange to hear everyone shouting "Vivat!" No matter, though – it was a lot like home.

Meeting held May 1st at the Walt Library, 6:30 PM CDT. Attendance: 22 in person, 2 online.

Officer reports:

- Exchequer (Lady Lhiannan): The barony account stands at \$12312.56. We received \$84.00 in income from selling Gold Key garb. One check remains outstanding. Locker rent is paid through the end of June. Need to have a financial committee meeting to approve buying more checks.
- Gold Key & Chatelaine (Lord Aurick): No changes to report. Discussion of Herdmaster planning.
- Arts and Sciences (Lord Bristol and Lady Azalais): May 15th = Mistress Gyda will lead us in making Viking treasure necklaces. If you have specific treasures you want to use for your necklace, bring them next week. Since so many members expect to attend Lilies War, A&S night for June is cancelled. The next A&S night will cover Norse mythology. The topic for 3rd quarter is garb accessories. They are seeking suggestions for future meeting activities.
- Chronicler (Her Ladyship Natalya, for Lord Carlos): Please send your Runestaff submissions to her by the 5th of May. Her goal is to have the Runestaff out by next week.
- Herald (Lord Jean): The Kingdom Herald has received the fees for registrations submitted; four are currently in process. One name was accepted, one device was rejected. One client remains to be processed.

- Media Cryer (Lord Jean): The Herdmaster flyer is under construction. Please get event information to Lord Jean so he can put together the promotional materials.
- Webminister (Lady Laurencia): Please send Lady Laurencia event information so she can post it on our website!
- Minister of Youth (Lady Adelheid): Lady Adel's background check is complete. No structured youth activities are planned for Herdmaster, but participants are welcome to make use of the box o'stuff she will bring. Lady Adel's plans for Lilies youth activities were posted on the Kingdom web page. She received an overwhelming response. So far, a D&D session is planned. She asks that we please feel free to volunteer to do an activity as a Barony. Lady Adel is seeking suggestions for youth activities for Coronation. Cattle Raids activities will be dairy- and cheese-themed.
- Largess Coordinator (Lady Marta): Not in attendance.
- Archery (Lord Yoichi): His kid's school concerts conflict with practice.
- Marshall's report (HE Volkmar): Fighter practices are every Tuesday at Woods Park. No cut-and-thrust, only heavy fighters. We may have captured a passer-by at the last practice.

Guild and Barony reports

- Scribes (HE Gyda): Who wants preprints? She can get more. The scribe for this reign is not known yet? There will be a scribal tent at Lilies.
- Music (HE Gwyneth): Practices are typically scheduled for the 1st and 3rd Thursdays at 7:30 PM, at Isadora and Volkmar's place. This month's schedule is going to be a little different. The 2 May practice was cancelled. The 16th is still on. Since May has 5 weeks, the 30th was decided as a practice night.
- Barony: Remember to send award recommendations! Send them to the correct place—the Barony can't help with Kingdom recommendations. Remember that Baronial events must be advertised in the Runestaff to be official.
- HE Uji was invited to join the Order of the Laurel!!! The best date to hold his vigil will be at Cattle Raids.
 Mistress Gyda will oversee the vigil. HE will not be present at the Barony meeting on the 29th.
- Lady Tofa's term as Seneschal is coming to an end. Please send your letters of interest to her and Their Excellencies at <u>seneschal@magmor.calontir.org</u>, <u>baron@magmor.calontir.org</u>, and <u>baroness@magmor.calontir.org</u>. The deadline is the end of May.
- A visitor from the East is visiting Lilies. We tentatively located a tent and rides to/from Kansas City for her.
- HE Isadora asked us to think about our plans for Lilies, especially with regard to the Baronial meal plan. Who will coordinate, who will cook, etc. We will discuss this more at the 15 May meeting.
- Volkmar and Isadora will not be at the meeting on the 15th. Can anyone take over the Zoom room that night? Thanks.

All Business

- Baronial Archery Championship and Herdmaster:
 - \circ Lord Yoichi couldn't make it the 19 $^{\rm th}$ due to a schedule conflict. We will wait to hear if this is resolved.
 - Rental of a portaloo for the event at Master Gerald's place? The rental fee for an accessible unit will probably exceed the limit of the Seneschal equipment rental budget for the year, so a financial committee meeting is needed to approve the added expense.
 - **Event start time is noon.** Combat will start at 1:00 PM, scheduled to last up to 2 hours. Archery shoot to follow. Court will take place at the end of the day's activities.

- Bring Your Own Lunch. There is no set time for a meal. We are responsible for our own picnics, but feel free to bring enough to share if you want.
- Financial Committee meeting. •
 - Voted to supplement the \$300 budgeted to the Seneschal so we can rent an accessible/extra-large porta-potty for Herdmaster.
 - Voted to purchase additional checks for the Exchequer.
- Coronation:
 - No schedule decided yet, but expect fighting and A&S.
 - Discussion regarding general prizes, coordinators of each activity will be responsible for ensuring availability of prizes.
- Cattle Raids:
 - The site has not sent us a contract yet. Have information (minus contract language) for insurance cost with and without equestrian.
 - The site has not confirmed whether we can have equestrian events. The equestrians are communicating directly with the site to make sure their needs are met.
 - If the equestrian guestion is not settled, we may substitute hobby-horse events (but we are holding out hope for real horses).
 - Need to touch base with feast steward?
 - We plan to make more cow keychains for site tokens. We are shooting to make 250-300 now.
