Item 1: Increase reimbursement authorized for Cattle Raids feast food expenses, requested by Chris Stuart


Feast for Cattle Raids feast is already sold out in Pre-Registration, with predicted/collected income of \$1200. The original expense allowance in the event budget was \$900.
