Officer reports:

- **Exchequer** Checking balance is \$13,819.09. Herdmaster donations = \$71.00. No outstanding checks, the storage locker is paid through June 30th.
- **Minister of A&S** Not much activity due to Lilies. July is a Kingdom Arts and Sciences discussion, "Harp Club" is planned for June 29th, location TBD.

Ein Ein pianckh zů machen

Wilt dù ain piannckh machen, Nim gewessert mánndl, reib sỷ Jn aim stain klain mit milch raủmb darinn, halb als Vill eis weis, reibs důrchainannder, darnach nim ain wenig maỷ půttern, las es zergeen, nit zủ hais, schüt Jn auch darein, reib es noch bas, rosnwasser unnd zůgger dartzue unnd wann die vj stuckh pej ainannder sein, so schlags wol durchainannder, darnach mach ain taig von eỷ weis, der dỷnn seỷ, las ein pfann mit saltz reiben, thůe den bůtter darein, las es hais werden, dann so schüt den bůttern wider heraus gannz und schüdt den taig darein, machs gleich ainer dorthen poden unnd wann er starkh Ist, so schüt das geriben darein, leg ain deckhel daraůf, kolen oben daraůf unnd allennthalben herůmb bis er ain wenig praůn wirt, so schneidt Jn zů praidten stůckhen alsdann, so Ist er gerecht.

To make a Blancmanger*

If you want to make a blancmanger, take almonds soaked in water, grind them finely in a mortar, add cream and half as much egg white, and stir it all together. Then take a little May butter, let it melt, but not too hot, pour it in as well, grind it well, add rose water and sugar, and when the six ingredients are combined, stir them all together well. Then make a thin batter from egg whites, rub a pan with salt, add butter, and let it heat. Then pour out the butter, put the batter in, and shape it like a [torte body? pie crust?]. When it's firm, pour in the grated [almond] mixture, put a lid on it, put coals on the lid and all around it until the batter turns a little brown. Then cut it into wide pieces, so is it good.

^{* &}quot;piannckh": The modern Swiss German translation calls this a Blancmanger. I have not found any source for the meaning of the original word. It somewhat resembles a medieval blancmanger in that it contains almonds, but the egg-white crust makes this more like a pie. It is not clear whether the "thin batter" for the crust contains other ingredients besides the egg whites; flour seems likely, creating a crepelike crust.


