
Letter from the Seneschal

Archery and Thrown Weapons Practice: On hold for the winter. Activity will resume in April.

Moot notes

Meeting held November 5, 2025, at Walt Library, 6:30 PM CDT.

Officer reports:

Exchequer (Isadora) – The Barony checking balance is \$14,481.80. There are two outstanding checks to Tofa (\$5.42) and to the Kingdom Waterbearers. The Waterbearers say they deposited the check, our balance says otherwise. The Paypal deposit was received for Kingdom A&S. The mystery extra \$20.00 from Kingdom A&S was finally identified—someone paid twice, so we are refunding one of them. We received \$33.00 in donations at the Archery championship. Storage rent is paid through December. Deposit checks from Saunders counties have been returned, along with thanks for being good renters! The Coronation contract is needed soonish; Cera will sign it. We need to discuss the 2026 budget, so a financial committee meeting was proposed to meet next week (12 Nov 2025).

- Minister of A&S (Azalais) This month's A&S meeting will take place the 19th. The topic will be Tablet Weaving, taught by Gyda. She has some loaner looms and yarn that newbies can use. Many materials can be used for tablets; cereal boxes are sturdy and thin enough to withstand the weaving process. See the Guild reports for Melodians news.
- Chronicler (Tofa) Updates to the membership directory take place this month. The old version of the Directory has been sent to Friends and Members of the Barony for everyone's review. The Runestaff deadline remains the 15th.
- **Herald (Jean)** LOAR news: things are still in process so nothing substantial to report. Lord Jean is moving, so we are seeking a replacement Herald! This is a Great Office and therefore filling the position is a requirement for us to continue as a Barony.

Media Cryer (Jean) – No posts on media lately.

- **Gold Key** –A short discussion on loaning took place. We are still working on loaner garb inventory, cleaning, and repair. Sometimes loaned garb doesn't get returned. We have a large inventory, so missing items haven't been considered a significant problem. We may consider creating matching sets or complete outfits for a core wardrobe to travel between events, then cull extraneous items. We cannot give away Baronial loaner garb to new members (501c3 orgs rules) but trading with other groups is OK. We will revisit culling at a different meeting.
- Chatelaine (Laurencia) The BLT Anime demo happened. Lots of interest was reported from folks local to both Lincoln and Omaha, good communication with BLT chatelaine. Upcoming demos: Walt library Mini Ren Faire is Dec 6th 11-3. Eleven volunteers, three tables requested. A possible demo at Constellation. This is a SciFi/Fantasy event at the Cornhusker hotel March 6th through March 8th 2026. This event doesn't conflict

with Gulf. Volunteers get free entrance to their booth, but not to other activities. Ne Swordfighters coming. So far, we don't have any plans for the demonstration. We will plan to brainstorm at the Dec 17th meeting and maybe recruit BLT for a joint effort. There are a lot of cons and other recruitment opportunities in the area. We will need to balance these ideas with planned events to not overwork our group.

- **Web Minister (Laurencia)** Officers, please check your emails regularly. Let her know if you have problems accessing your account. Announcements shared in the MM Corral on Facebook will get posted elsewhere online.
- **Minister of Youth (Adel)** Crown Tourney is taking place 8 Nov 2025. Leofwyna is taking point on Youth activities during Mag Mor Yule Court in January. Coronation theme has not been planned yet.
- **Largess Coordinator (Martine)** The next fifth Wednesday is New Year's Eve. We will not have a meeting that night, so April 29th is the next Largess Night. Tentative plans for Cattle Raids or newcomer's items were offered.
- Knights Marshal No fighter practice at this time. The current practice site isn't working out and the Lighthouse no longer fits our needs, either. Approaching the Lincoln Public Schools system was discussed. LPS elementary gymnasiums can be rented for \$55 for two hours. Availability to us may depend on the LPS policy regarding martial arts. A high school gym may cost more, assuming combat is an accepted activity. We have lots of useless bits of armor, which need culling and discarding.
- **Archery** We have received a donation of eight loaner bows (four lefties, four right-handed) from Owain. The current stock of Baronial loaner arrows is suitable for these bows but we only have enough for two or three people. Please contact Yoichi if you would like to borrow archery equipment.

New business:

- 1. The Coronation flyer is ready to distribute.
- 2. Yule Court will be held at St. Mark's on the Campus, Lincoln, NE, 4 Jan 2026. Start time ~12:30 PM.
 - a. The Yule Court budget was not discussed tonight; the financial committee meeting is scheduled for the 12^{th} .
 - b. Site fee is freewill donation and will be given to St. Mark's.
 - c. Activities:
 - i. Camaraderie with friends, white elephant exchange (max \$20), children's activity will be a Highland cow ornament made of buttons, and a game of bean bag toss. There will be an informal table decoration competition, judged by the populace.
 - d. Feast: main dishes and lemonade will be provided, as we had an excess of food from previous events. Participants are asked to bring salads/sides, breads, and desserts.
 - i. Cera has sent a link to the potluck signup sheet via the Mag Mor Listserv.
 - Baronial A&S Championship may take place at Yule. The theme TBD.
- 3. **Side conversations:** There is potential for us to host three events in 2026: Coronation, Masters of the Duel, and Cattle Raids. There will be more discussion later.




