

January Finance Committee Meeting Minutes

On February 18, 2026, the Mag Mor Financial Committee met at Walt Library. The meeting started at 6:43PM.

Cattle Raids 2-26 Event Bid:

Lady Azalais, Lord Istvan, and Mistress Gyda presented a bid for Cattle Raids 2026 for approval by the Financial Committee. The event would be held on August 21 - 23, 2026, at the Saunders County Fairgrounds, using the whole fairgrounds site. Activities will include equestrian, rattan and C&T combat, archery, A&S competitions, lunch inn, and feast. Estimated attendance is 200. Total estimated expenses total \$5,073.

Baron Uji moved that the Finance Committee approve the bid for Cattle Raids 2026. Lady Emma seconded the motion. The motion carried, with 5 votes and 2 abstentions (bid proposers abstained).

Meeting ended at 7:06 PM.

Herald's Table

Welcome back to Istvan's Heraldry Corner! This month we're taking a break from the educational side to announce

ISTVAN'S HERALDIC DISPLAY CHALLENGE

The challenge is simple, by the beginning of Lilies (June 5th, 2026) create a piece of heraldic display to shore up Mag Mor's title as "the center of all coolness and knowledge in the Known World".

To Enter: By June 5th, show me/send me pictures of some item you have created to display a piece of heraldry.

If you are basing it off a period item, light documentation is welcome.

Rules:

- ❖ The item must contain some new work begun on or after March 4th, 2026 (March Moot). This gives you three months to complete it. For example, adding your arms to a garb item you've already made is acceptable, but a banner you've already finished is not.
- ❖ You may use any piece of heraldry, you do not have to use your own registered heraldry. For example, if you don't have registered heraldry (like Istvan), you can make a banner with the barony's populace badge on it (see the January Runestaff!) and/or Calontir's populace symbols.
- ❖ Entries will be judged by Their Excellencies Mag Mor and Istvan.
- ❖ Team entries are welcome, and you may submit multiple entries.
- ❖ Prize: To Be Announced. If you have something you would like to give as a prize, please contact Istvan of Mag Mor (Ayden Eddings on Facebook, herald@magmor.calontir.org).
- ❖ Ideas: I would be remiss to not offer some inspiration.
 - A banner – The classic choice!
 - Put a piece of your heraldry on a box of feast gear or sewing kit
 - Add your device to your garb in some fashionable way
 - Paint a shield/Piece of your fighting gear
 - Create a medallion for a baronial order*
 - A token with your arms to be given to a friend/partner/enemy
 - A Heraldic Dog Coat

*I would advise against making one for the baronial martial orders, since those badges are subject to change at this time. See March Moot Minutes.


No pets allowed on site. **Site is DRY.**


